

# Caribbean Stud Poker

Caribbean Stud poker offers the player the challenge of poker, but uses an easier-to-play format – plus the first progressive play jackpot ever offered with a table game.

Caribbean Stud Poker is played on a special table similar to Blackjack, and is based on the five-card stud poker game. To play, each player antes, with the option of playing for a progressive jackpot, and receives five cards face down. The Dealer gets five cards, with one card face up. The player then examines his hand and decides to fold, forfeiting the ante, or to make an additional bet, doubling his ante.

The dealer can only play with an Ace/King or better. If the Dealer can't open, and the player wins the hand, the player is paid on his ante bet only.

## CARIBBEAN STUD POKER TERMS

### **ANTE BET**

Each player makes this opening bet in order to play

### **PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT BET**

Each player has the option of making an additional bet in order to participate in the Progressive Jackpot, players can win all or part of the jackpot with hands of Royal Flush, Straight Flush, Four of a Kind, Full House, or Flush.

### **FOLD**

The player can forfeit his ante bet after the cards are dealt if he thinks his hand cannot beat the Dealer's.

### **BET TO CALL THE DEALER**

The player can place an additional bet that is exactly twice the amount of his ante bet, if he thinks his hand will beat the Dealer's.



## DEALER'S BET

The Dealer must have an Ace/King or higher to open. If the dealer cannot open, the hand is over, and the players who stayed in the hand are paid their antes only.

## BONUS PAYOUTS

The player may be eligible for a Bonus Payout if he beats the Dealer with any of the hands described in the following:

### BONUS PAYOUTS SCHEDULE

One pair	even money
Two pairs	2 to 1
Three of a Kind	3 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Flush	5 to 1
Full House	7 to 1
Four of a Kind	20 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
Royal Flush	100 to 1

These payoffs are normal table payoffs, and are in addition to the Progressive Jackpot payoff.

The player can place an optional bet for the Progressive Jackpot at the same time he places his ante bet. Simply drop the coin into the acceptor slot located in the front of each player. The player qualifies for the Progressive Jackpot by being dealt one of the five hands listed. Players may win a Progressive Jackpot payoff even if the dealer has a higher hand. Should two or more players qualify for the Royal Flush Progressive Jackpot during the same hand, the first player to the left of the dealer shall win the displayed amount, the second player will win the seed amount of the Progressive Jackpot.

### PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT PAYOFFS

Royal Flush	100%
Straight Flush	10%
Four of a Kind	\$500
Full House	\$100
Flush	\$50

Misdeal voids all hands and payoffs.
